President's Report: Dean's Mtg. Heather reported on Goals and Priorities of EGSS-

EGSS Conference-Elizabeth Wood-Academic Dean suggested EGSS include/connect EdUS students. Discussed offering reduced rate to undergrads (to include food) and volunteer opportunities during the days of conference, and perhaps providing a workshop and lunch to undergrads specifically. Regular Rate: \$35.00, EdUS \$15. (to be discussed with faculty and conference

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Sarah DesRoches to get feedback from her undergrads-Would they attend? Heather received email about food waste from Dean's office. It was suggested leftover food delivered to shelter (though most programs won't accept "fresh food items"-EGSS has always shared leftover food with our students. Will plan and develop a policy to deliver food after conference.

Conference dates: Dean asked if we would consider changing our EGSS conference date to coincide with Faculty of Ed. Symposium on Comparative Education planned for April-May 2011. Jessica suggested we collaborate with EdUS. There are more students at McGill in March for the student conference. Sarah Desroches made excellent point that our conference is low key. Jessica suggested winner of EGSS presents at spring symposium or CISE conf.?
